Public Meetings:

The Chesaning Township Board meets at 7:30 p.m. on the first Thursday of each month, at the Township Hall.

The Township Planning Commission meets quarterly, at 7 p.m., at the Township Hall. Planning Commission 2018 tentative meeting dates: Feb 7, May 2, Aug 1, Nov 7.

Building Permits:

All new construction and anything other than ordinary maintenance on existing buildings will require a permit. Building, electrical, plumbing and mechanical permits are obtained at the Township Office.

Well and Septic permits are issued by the Saginaw County Health Department. For questions regarding the Chesaning Township Zoning Ordinance or Construction Codes, please contact:

Wildwood Cemetery:

Grave Burial Permits are available for purchase by the public, with reduced rates for Chesaning Township Residents. Call (989) 845-2341.

Dog License prior to March 1 each year, are available from the Township Treasurer. State Law (PA 195 of 1969, Sec. 6) requires dog owners to show proof of valid rabies vaccination and expiration date to obtain a dog license. Vet's proof must be shown for unsexed dogs to obtain a reduced fee license.

Voting:

Residents may register to vote with the Township Clerk Frances Kukulis, at the Township Office, or by calling (989) 845-2341.

To be eligible to vote in future elections, a resident must be a citizen of the United States, a 30 day resident of Chesaning Township and at least 18 years of age, by Election Day.

Taxes – Real & Personal Property:

The Tax Rolls and Personal Appraisal Cards are open for inspection during regular business hours.

Current assessments are completed each year by the March Board of Review, with no additional changes allowed following the close of the March Board of Review.

Summer taxes become due July 1 of the taxing year and are payable to the Township Treasurer on or before September 14. Summer taxes paid after September 14 and prior to March 1 of the next year with added interest are also payable at the Township Treasurer's Office.

Winter taxes become due December 1 of the taxing year, and are payable to the Township Treasurer on or before February 14 of the following year.

Taxes paid after March 1 following the taxing year, are no longer accepted at the township level, but must be paid to the Saginaw County Treasurer's Office, 111 S. Michigan Ave., Saginaw, MI 48602. (989)790-5225.

If taxes are in escrow, the bank, mortgage company, or tax service must request the property tax bill amount from the township, and a copy of the tax bill will be sent to the property owner.

Please check your assessed valuation carefully. Report any errors to your Township Supervisor immediately at (989)845-2341. Also, please check your legal description carefully and report any errors to the county Equalization Department at (989)790-5260.

Every homeowner is entitled to one **Principal Residence Exemption (PRE)** on the local school millage, with applications available in the Treasurer's Office.

Refuse & Recycling: Non-Village residents of Chesaning Township are assessed on their winter tax notice. Refuse and recycling is picked up weekly on Thursday, with the exception of holiday weeks, when pickup is delayed one day. A list of acceptable items is available in the Township Office, or at www.recyclemotion.org.

The Chart on the Facing Page indicates the amount paid for each \$1000 of Taxable Property Value.

Example: A Township PRE Property with Taxable Value of \$50,000 would be:
